Dear Madam,

Please find below additional information requested related to the non-subjugation application form.

QC - 1. The promoter must validate this information, particularly with the Avataq cultural institute, and if necessary, explain what measures it intends to take to prevent and mitigate the impacts on it, particularly the visual impacts.

After consulting with the Avataq Cultural Institute, it was identified that there would be archaeological sites nearby. (See Appendix I.) Zone A, which would correspond to the IcGn-3 point, would be pre-Dorset sites, which were recorded in 1986 and 1992. There would also be archaeological structures present in zone B but today they would be destroyed. Furthermore, IcGm-29 and IcGm-47 are destroyed and no protected sites were observed at these two locations.

In order to reduce impacts on these protected sites, it is recommended that 100-meter perimeter be maintained to avoid disturbing them. That's why we decided to relocate the future quarry site. (See

appendices II and III.) This future site would then be outside the protected areas, at a minimum perimeter of 100 meters.
